<b>PRESENTATION / OBJECTIVES</b>	
<p>The objective of the module is to combine the development of language skills with the cultural discovery of heritage: <b>literature, history and architecture</b>.  The courses favor an <b>interactive approach</b> and organizational methods aimed at encouraging the learner's involvement (group work, research on files). The devices are based on <b>diversified media</b> (audio, videos, texts, etc.) <b>and visits</b> integrated into the learning sequences.</p>	
<b>CONTENTS – SESSION 2</b>	
<p><b>SEQUENCE 1 – 10.5 hours (7.5 hours of lessons + 3 hours of visits)</b></p> <p><b>HISTORY IN NORMANDY</b></p> <p>The purpose of the module is to discover and deepen aspects of the history of France concerning Normandy. From the Middle Ages to contemporary times, students will alternate lessons with the preparation of guided tours.</p>	
<p><b>SEQUENCE 2 - 7.5 hours of lessons</b></p> <p><b>WRITERS FROM/IN NORMANDY</b></p> <p><b>ANNIE ERNAUX</b></p> <p>Annie Ernaux, born near Le Havre in 1940, is one of the greatest representatives of contemporary French literature; she was awarded with the Nobel Prize for Literature in 2022. The course offers students the discovery of this Norman author and the essential issues of her work, as well as the reading of the autobiographical text <i>L'Autre fille</i>.</p>	

### SEQUENCE 3 – **12 hours** (*5 hours of lessons + 7 hours of visits*)

#### ARCHITECTURE IN NORMANDY

The course aims to study and discover the architectural heritage of Normandy and is based on guided tours of the sites mentioned (for example, the Abbaye aux Dames, Abbaye d'Ardenne-IMEC, Château de Fontaine-Henry, campus and city of Caen).
