PRESENTATION / OBJECTIVES

The module combines lessons that articulate practice of the French language and preparation for visits (12 hours) and educational visits supervised by teachers of French as a foreign language (FFL) (10.5 hours)

SEQUENCE 1 – FFL and History

From the Middle Ages to the Second World War, you will be invited to enrich your knowledge of French with a varied lexicon but also with a grammar that renders the nuances linked to the mastery of time. Several excursions, among others in the medieval town of Bayeux, will offer you a linguistic and historical immersion in the heritage of our region.



SEQUENCE 2 – Trip to Normandy and gastronomy

Through this module, you will discover some aspects of Normandy's cultural heritage and French gastronomy: the course will provide you with knowledge and linguistic tools (lexicon, grammatical structures, cultural information, etc.) to prepare for educational outings (for example, visit to the Bayeux Tapestry and a snail farm, cooking workshop with a chef...). During the visits, you will be able to put into practice the tools seen in class.
